### **Flux in Thailand Delivers Continuous Production Operations**

As reported by the media, the central part of Thailand, including certain districts of the Bangkok area, is experiencing severe flooding from a stronger than normal seasonal rainfall.

Nevertheless, as a matter of precaution, Flux has launched a risk mitigation plan, which will minimize the risk of any flooding reaching the interior of our premises and which will secure continuity of our production operations and deliveries to our customers in the event that our facility becomes directly affected by the situation.
